IDEMITSU MOTO4 ASIA CUP

Launched in 2014, the Idemitsu Moto4 Asia Cup is a premier motorcycle racing competition that discovers and develops young riders from across Asia and Oceania. Organized by MotoGP Sports Entertainment Group and overseen by renowned talent scout Alberto Puig, the M4A is a key stepping stone into the world of international road racing.

HOW TO BECOME A MOTO4 ASIA CUP RIDER?

Each season, 20 riders are selected to compete. Some will return from the previous year, while new talents will be added through the annual Selection Event, held this year at Sepang International Circuit (Malaysia) on October 27 & 28, 2026. To take part, riders must apply online. Around 100 applicants will be invited to the event by the Selection Committee.

ABOUT THE CHAMPIONSHIP

The 2026 season consists of 12 races held at 6 events. 5 of them, as a support category to MotoGP™ in Thailand, Japan, Indonesia, Malaysia & Qatar.

The organization provides all riders with Honda NSF250R bikes and full racing equipment.

Moreover, riders are being guided by Alberto Puig as well as being trained how to set up the bike by our experienced technical crew.

The organization also takes care of all logistics, set up and medical insurance as well as accommodation and on-site transportation at all events. Riders only cover costs for flight tickets (also booked by the organization) and food.

DO I NEED RACING EXPERIENCE?

Not necessarily. We're looking for raw talent and exceptional riding skills. Riders with backgrounds in motocross, dirt-track, mini-bikes, scooters, or racing schools are encouraged to apply—even without formal road racing experience.

FUTURE RACING CAREER

MotoGP Sports Entertainment Group follows the racing career of the most talented riders competing in the Idemitsu Moto4 Asia Cup.

Top riders from the 2014 to 2025 editions are now racing in the Red Bull MotoGP Rookies Cup and the MotoJunior World Championship fighting for the podium. One rider from the first editions is now racing in the MotoGP™ World Championship; Ai Ogura. Five riders are already participating in the Moto2 World Championship: Ayumu Sasaki, Deniz Oncü, Mario Aji, Taiyo Furusato and Senna Agius. And 4 Alumni compete in Moto3; Ryusei Yamanaka, Veda Prataman, Zen Mitani and Hakim Danish.
